Dances this year the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office will sponsor two summer camps for 5th grade students who have completed the Drug Education Program successfully. This camp is designed to build confidence, self-esteem, social skills, and team building skills through various instruction and activities.

This week long camp will be filled with instruction, fun activities, swimming, competitive events and much more. There will be presentations and demonstrations presented by members of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, and other Lincoln County Public Safety Agencies. There will be activities to build teamwork skills as well as individual life skills, and opportunities to increase your child's confidence and enhance their conflict resolution skills. The students who are selected for camp will be required to adhere to a strict set of rules and stay in camp the entire week. These rules must be obeyed at all times.

The camp has limited availability and participants will be selected from all schools in Lincoln County. To be eligible for consideration your child must have successfully completed the Drug Education Program presented by the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office. If your child has completed the Drug Education Program and will be going into the 6th grade in the 2018/2019 school year and you want your child to be considered for participation in the summer camp, please fill out the attached application.

Successful applicants will be notified by mail, make sure you include your mailing address.

Please be sure to complete the entire application. This is very important. The information that we have requested is needed for the care and safety of your child. Parent's night is scheduled for June 7th the first week of camp and June 14th the second week. Parent's night is designed to give the parents an opportunity to see what their children did at camp all week. It promises to be a lot of fun for everyone.
