TEAM LEADER MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION

1. Must be a **Sophomore, Junior or Senior** level high school student in good standing with their school. (living within Lincoln County)
3. Maintain an accumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
4. Maintain a clean personal background, with no criminal history.
5. Outgoing, proactive personality who enjoys working with middle school age youth. Must have a sense of humor, willing to lead and have a "take-charge attitude."
6. Complete the LCSO Team Leader application.
7. Complete all required training as determined by the Sheriff's Office.
8. Write a one page typed essay explaining the reasons they want to be a team leader, future intentions and plans for education and life.
9. Provide one professional letter of reference (from a non-family member).
10. Obtain three professional reference signatures on their application.
11. Must be able to commit to 2 meetings a month with no less than 70% attendance. Students must provide a schedule for all school activities that may cause you to miss a meeting.
12. Must be able to spend one week, overnight at the camp, demonstrate the qualities of an excellent role model. You will not be allowed to leave for games, vacation etc.
